<b>Submission check</b>	<b>Words to be included from course readings</b>	<b>My comments on number/kinds of words you included</b> -based on the sophistication of words you use well in speaking and writing (individualized comments)
<b>1<sup>st</sup></b>	<b>AWL Sublist 1 Academic culture (AC) Multiple Intelligence</b>	<b>Student 1 example:</b> You have very few of the AC news words in your PVO. However, your essay about “cheating” showed you could have used more specific vocabulary from the AC unit. Remember, the PVO is for the words you DO NOT USE well.
<b>2<sup>nd</sup></b>	<b>AWL Sublist 2 Clean Energy unit United Nations/ Refugees</b>	<b>Student 2 Example:</b> Since you are an experienced engineer, I can see why you have few energy unit words. I believe you know those words already☺. No problem.
<b>final</b>	<b>AWL Sublist 3 Global Citizenship Genetically Modified Foods</b>	<b>Student 3 Example:</b> Now I see why you had so much trouble with the GMO readings and essay. If you had put the new words in your PVO, you would have been able to access/review/ use them more easily.
