

ABC Generic Game Board Instructions

This is a generic game board that I created for topics and grammar review. Over time I will post the other Card Sets on my website.

You will need:

- ABC Generic Game Board – best size is 11 X 14
- 1 set of A, B and C cards for each group
 - Printed double sided so A, B and C cards are easy to organize
 - It's best if they are different colors (easier for you to sort later)
 - Place the cards on the A B C space with the letters facing up.
- 1 die for each group
- Tokens for each person (or they supply coins, etc.)

Description of A- B – C Cards

- **A cards** are usually opinion. They need to explain their answers (no room on the card to say that). Grammar set - usually a theme and they use target grammar.
- **B cards** are more fact or vocabulary related. They need to explain the meaning or use the word in a sentence. Grammar set – usually correct the sentence or ID if it's correct or not
- **C cards** are for consequences (the fun part!) These fit the theme.

Step by step Instructions (Don't assume they all know how to play board games).

Essentially, they roll the die, move their token, pick up the appropriate card

1. **Distribute** all the materials to each group (above. A group of 3 is best with 4 (max)
2. They put their tokens on START
3. **Explain the goal** is for the 1st person to reach the FINISH
4. **Model** how to answer one A, B and C card by reading the prompt and “answering”
5. **Learners Play**
 - a. If the person with the prompt, doesn't know the answer, the others can help.
 - b. If one hasn't reached FINISH and the cards are all used, they can reshuffle the cards and continue.
 - c. OR You could set a time limit and the winner is closest to “finish”

Facilitators roam to help them understand the prompt, to keep them on topic, etc.

6. **Debrief** Ask if anyone has questions about the prompts

Re: Love/ Family Set of A, B, C cards (unusual because there are 2 themes)

- These were written for Valentine's Day and Family Day (February)
- The ?1 set is about Love/ Dating and ?2 set is about Family
- I suggest that you combine the 1 & 2 sets to have more cards, so they should be printed in the same color.
- A Cards – Opinion – they explain their opinion
B Cards – Idioms – they give the meaning
C. Consequences – this is the fun part and shows who is competitive!
