## Most Common Emotion / Experience Words

When we talk about ourselves and experience life, we use emotion words (adjectives).

Put a ● mark beside the words you know.

Look up the words you don't know and make a personal sentence about them.

[by,at, about with + Noun] These words often go with some emotion words.

“I feel/ am \_\_\_\_\_”

Meaning or sentence about when you feel/ felt this way.

Example:

*I am so frustrated with the government office.*

Proud (of, about)	
Relaxed* (with, about)

Worried * (about, by +N)	

\* The words with a \* can be used with ING to talk about other things, people or events.

Examples: *The letter is confusing because I don't know all the words. VS I was confused when I read her letter.*

*What a confusing letter! Who wrote it? / I was confused by her body language. What did she mean?*
