

Group Speaking Practice

(More Common Emotion words)

- Get into groups of 3
- **Roll 2 dice.** Add the dice to get a number.
- Make a sentence with the word of the number you rolled.
- You can use either the ED (emotion) or ING (things & experiences) form

Example: If you roll the dice and get a total number of 7, you need to make a sentence with bored or boring.

You could say:

“I **was bored** while I was watching the crime show last night. It was so easy to figure out.”

OR “The movie I watched last night **was so boring!** Even my child didn’t like it.

(Your leader might choose a topic that you all talk about such as “being a student”.)
